The HGGS offers mostly compact courses with a duration of one to two days:

1st year:

- Introductory Workshop
- Foundation Seminar on Inter- and Transdisciplinarity
- Interdisciplinary Research Colloquium
- Interdisciplinary Seminar (i): Concepts, Methods, Theories

2nd year: Focus on Field Work or Archives, international academic mobility

2nd - 3rd year:

- Interdisciplinary Seminar (ii): Concepts, Methods, Theories
- Interdisciplinary Research Colloquium (year 2 or 3)
- Lecture/Workshop with Guest Professor*
- Summer/Winter School or international Conference*

- Peer Mentoring Projects at the HGGS
- HGGS-GradAcad Collaboration: Transferable Skills Workshops
