## **LEGAL PREMISES FOR THE RECONFIGURATION OF THE REGULATING FRAMEWORK OF THE REFERENDUM**

### **Abstract**

In this thesis, essential legal assumptions for the normative reconfiguration of the referendum in pursuit of its democratization will be based. For this purpose, historical and theoretical references of its configuration will be systematized, normative references will be identified from a comparative perspective from the analysis of the configuration of the referendum in Latin America and the legal assumptions for the reconfiguration will be argued. According to the expected scientific results, the democratization of the referendum implies its normative reconfiguration based on essential legal assumptions such as: the recognition and expansion of the mandatory referendum, the recognition and optimization of the popular extension of the referendum referral, as well as the Legal predetermination of the binding effects and responsibilities of public authorities.
